A 'Big Event' will be held once a quarter for students who have earned 40 brag bands per quarter for following the expectations on the school behavior matrix. When a student is 'caught' following a school-wide expectation, they have the opportunity to get a band. The count restarts each quarter. Students who do not earn enough will be re-taught the expectations so that they can work to attend the next quarter. We want **all** students to be able to attend a Big Event. A different aspect of PAWS will be emphasized each quarter. First quarter will be 'Polite and respectful', Second quarter will be "Act responsible", Third Quarter will be 'Work hard' and fourth quarter will be 'Stay Safe'. A short 10-15 minute lesson will be taught once a week. Other lessons will be taught on an 'as needed' basis.
