	Nursery Rhymes All Around! Through nursery rhymes we will work on math and literacy while also doing art and cooking
	Pirates and Mermaids Argh Matey! Climb aboard our class pirate ship as we explore ocean plants and animals! We will use our trusty treasure maps to navigate the ocean and search for buried treasure! I can't wait to "sea" you this summer!
	Folk Tales, and Fairy Tales, and Fables Oh My! Join me as we cook up some 'Stone Soup', make a castle for 'Rapunzel', build a house for 'The Three Little Pigs', help Jack up the Beanstalk, and more!
	Ocean Animals and Exploring the Beach! Get ready for a fun and exploration time at the beach. Students will explore the ocean habitat, including the plants and animals that live there. A few of our books that we will look at will be "Rainbow Fish" and "Commotion in the Ocean". We will also practice routines for your new and exciting year as a Kindergartener!
	Water, Water, Everywhere! Take a dive into the ocean, as we learn all about ocean animals and their habitat! Jump into water transportation exploration, while creating your own boat, and testing if it sinks or floats! Learn about water conservation and the water cycle through fun science experiments! We will end the class, with fun water games!

	<p>Come and learn about literacy, math, and science through an exciting simulated camping experience! Kids will join the “campsite,” complete with real tents in the classroom and learn how to prepare for a camping trip. We will make trail mix, search for animal tracks, make birdfeeders, and more! We will also study creatures of all sorts that are native to the Ozarks. This is learning at its best with an outdoor focus! We will conclude our time at "Camp Cub" with a day of camping and fun outdoor activities!</p>
	<p>Summer school is sure to be a blast as we travel through the solar system exploring the majesty of the sun, moon, constellations, and other planets! We will be covering literacy, math, writing and science on our journey through outer space. As we begin, we will research interesting facts about the sun, design models of the planets using household materials, and use our imagination to write our very own legend about how a constellation came to be. Students will get to make moon sand, and participate in a “Moon Jump Olympics” where they will calculate how far he/she would be able to jump on the moon. The class will come to a close as students work together to design “The Ultimate Rocket Launcher”!</p>
	<p>Join us this summer as we become meteorologists and explore "Wild & Wacky Weather". Students will be covering reading, writing, math and science while learning about different types of storms, the water cycle, clouds, types of precipitation, wind and solar energy. Students will be able to do science experiments and fun crafts to learn about these different areas. We will have a super fun, wacky time learning about the weather and how it affects us each day.</p>

	<p>Chocolate Shop Join me for a PBL project that is fun and tastes great. We will make and eat Chocolate for a good cause. Students will learn about goods and services, supply and demand, counting money, how to fill out a job application and what behaviors are expected at a job.</p>
	<p>A Camping We Will Go! Join us as we learn all about how to prepare for a camping trip! We will make some basic campfire foods, learn how to tie knots, learn about the wildlife you may encounter, and basic safety of the outdoors! All this will gear us up for our "camping trip" the last week! We will have tents, s'mores, campfire stories and songs! Want to know what you can do when you are camping? Join us and find out!</p>
